COVID-19 has presented many challenges to local entrepreneurs and communities. The Rural Relief and Recovery Fund (RRRF) loan program allowed CF Big Country to inject \$790,000 into the community through partially forgivable loans. The program also supported projects such as:

- DMS Main Street ShopHere Program (\$1,120) partnership with CF EntreCorp
- Business Support Voucher Program (\$26,480)

During the year, we were also able to begin projects such as:

- Horsethief Canyon Sea-Can Project—partnership with Starland County to retrofit a shipping container as a retail opportunity, another tourism development experience for the Valley.
- Drum Discovery Project partnership with Drumheller & District Chamber of Commerce, Town of Drumheller, Travel Drumheller and MH Enterprises to develop and provide a customer service Ambassador pilot project
- Building Enhancement Grant partnership with Drumheller & District Chamber of Commerce, Town of Drumheller to provide support to local businesses to update the exterior or interior of their location.
